RULES

These rules have been prepared to regulate the Photographic Competition (hereinafter the CONTEST) under the slogan: Fishing Photographers organized by Stella Maris Vigo (hereinafter the ORGANIZER).

The ORGANISER shall decide and interpret any issues that may arise during the development of the contest and that are not provided for in this document without the right to review or appeal its decision.

1ST PARTICIPANTS

The COMPETITION shall be open to all those persons who can prove their status as seamen-fishermen on board a vessel flying the Spanish flag or belonging to a joint fishing company with a licence issued by the Spanish maritime captaincy. This condition will be accredited with a photo of the professional seaman-fishermen's card, DIM or Maritime Book, indicating the name of the vessel on which he is enrolled when sending the photo. The organisers reserve the right to consult with the harbour master's office regarding the role of the boat.

2ND THEME

The main theme will be to show the daily activity related to fishing both at sea and on land and in all its aspects: fishing action, maintenance, nets and tackle, food, leisure, social relations, health, safety, meteorology, etc.

Images that show the work and activity in the conditions of the marine environment will be especially valued, as well as those that highlight the value of the service to society that fishing activity offers.

3RD WORKS

Each participant may submit a maximum of 3 works, which must be original and unpublished and must not have been submitted previously in other competitions, websites or any other digital or printed media. Participants are fully responsible for being the sole authors, for the absence of third-party rights, as well as for any claim for image rights on the works submitted to the competition.

Photographs may be taken with any medium, including mobile phones, and may not be altered electronically or by any other means. Photomontages or images made, totally or

partially, by Artificial Intelligence programs will not be accepted. Minimal colour and luminosity corrections will be allowed. In case of doubt, the jury may ask the author for the original file for verification.

4TH PRESENTATION

The works must be sent in JPEG digital format, with a resolution of 300 dpi and a minimum size of 1 Mb and a maximum of 3Mb.

The name of the file will be formed with the following data and in this order:

- Name and first surname of the author - Title of the work.
- Example: John Huston - Dawn on board.

5ª SENDING

The works will be sent by e-mail to the following address: direccion@stellamarisvigo.com

The subject of the e-mail will be: 'Stella Maris Vigo Photographic Competition'.

In the body of the e-mail, the following details of the author shall be included:

- Name,
- surname,
- seaman-fishermen's licence,
- date of birth,
- author's country,
- telephone number and e-mail address.

6. DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES

The deadline for submitting works will be open for three months, from 1 June to 31 August 2024. Works submitted after this date will not be accepted.

7TH PRIZES

First Prize: 400 euros, Second Prize: 300 euros. In addition, 3 runners-up prizes of 100 euros will be awarded.

8TH RULING

The jury's decision will take place on 14 September 2024 and will be expressly communicated by THE ORGANISER to the winners. Likewise, THE ORGANISER may disseminate information about the decision to the media and through the channels it deems appropriate.

9TH JURY AND AWARDING OF THE PRIZE

The jury of the CONTEST, composed of three members, appointed by the ORGANISER, will select, according to criteria of creativity and technical quality, the best photographs, scoring

each work between 1 and 10, there being no possibility that any work will not be judged as it or the jurors understand that it does not fall within the theme, as they will have passed the admission by the ORGANISER.

10TH AUTHORSHIP

The intellectual property and authorship of all works submitted shall always belong to the author. The ORGANISER shall state the name of the author in future reproductions in print or by any digital means.

Participants in the CONTEST authorise the ORGANISER to publish the photographs in any of its media (Newsletter, Website, Social Networks...).

The works submitted may be exhibited at the end of the COMPETITION.

11TH DATA PROTECTION

In accordance with the General Decree of the Spanish Episcopal Conference on Data Protection of the Catholic Church in Spain approved by the CIX Plenary Assembly of the Spanish Episcopal Conference, which has obtained the recognition of the Congregation for Bishops of the Holy See, by decree dated 22 May 2018 according to Article 91. 1 of Regulation (EU)2016/679, of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016, by signing this document, and as applicant, to collect, process and store the personal data included in this document, which will be processed in a lawful, loyal, transparent and adequate, relevant, limited, accurate and up-to-date manner, in accordance with the values proper to the Catholic Church, and in accordance with the protection of your personal dignity; all for the purpose of accrediting and/or verifying that the person authorised to collect the sacramental certificate is the person designated by the applicant who holds the legitimate right. Your data will be kept in accordance with canonical regulations and according to the instruction about parish sacramental books, of obligatory compliance, according to the norm of c. 455.1, approved by the Plenary Assembly of the Episcopal Conference; being deposited in the Diocesan Historical Archive. The applicant may exercise their rights of access, rectification, limitation, portability, cancellation, and opposition to the processing of their data by sending a written communication to the e-mail address dpo@diocesetuivigo.org or by ordinary mail to the Bishopric of Tui-Vigo - Diocesan Delegate for Data Protection, Doctor Corbal, 90 (36207) Vigo.

12TH ACCEPTANCE OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Participation in this CONTEST implies full acceptance of each and every one of these rules and the unappealable decision of the jury.

THE ORGANIZER reserves the right to modify at any time the conditions of these rules, including its possible cancellation before the deadline, provided there is just cause, pledging to communicate the new rules, conditions of the promotion or final cancellation, if any, with sufficient notice.

The ORGANISER is exempt from any liability that may arise from possible errors in the data provided by the winning participants, if it is not possible to identify and/or locate them.
